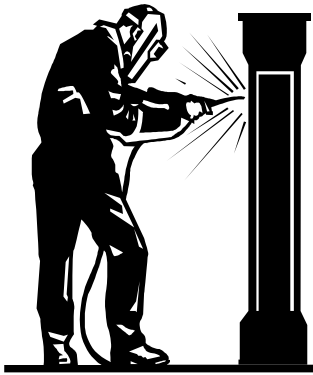
Nomination came from a variety of sources, including customers, vendors, government officials and economic development specialists.
